



SARRA TRAINING DAY

Are you (and your partner) looking for a challenge for 2012? We suggest that you try something new: **regularity rallying**. This level of grassroots motorsport allows you to use your “every-day” car and all that is needed initially is a stopwatch and a clipboard, and two people – driver and navigator!

The challenge with this form of rallying is to use speed, distance and time calculations to ensure that you follow the route exactly on time. Marshals clock the competitors along the route and penalties are counted in seconds with the lowest score winning.

The South African Regularity Rally Association (SARRA) is running a training day for new comers to be able to compete in regularity rallies and for existing rallyists to hone their skills for the season ahead

Experienced rallyists will provide training and guidance for newcomers as well as in-depth discussion for existing crews. Following the training session, a short practice rally will be run followed by a Treasure Hunt Fun Run
